The Universal College Student Transit Pass (U-Pass) program upgrades your existing Cal State LA student ID to a transit pass.

To qualify for the U-Pass program, you must be a currently enrolled Cal State LA student.

Once you have purchased Metro U-Pass, you'll receive a card or a sticker, both of which feature smart-chip technology. It's good for unlimited rides on all Metro rail and bus, Culver CityBus, GTrans, LADOT-DASH, Torrance Transit, Long Beach Transit, Montebello Bus Lines, Norwalk Transit, Pasadena Transit and Santa Monica Big Blue Bus.

U-Pass is not valid on Metrolink.



Your Cal State LA U-Pass works like a TAP card. Just tap your campus ID or U-Pass card on the TAP target before you board. Note: You must tap twice on first-time use.

The U-Pass is valid on any of the 25 Metro transit systems throughout LA County that accept TAP cards.

There is a replacement fee for lost U-Pass. No refunds will be issued—no exceptions.

To purchase your Metro U-Pass:

- Complete the Metro registration survey at lametro.formstack.com/forms/upass_csula.
- 2. Bring proof of survey completion and your Cal State LA identification card to the Transportation Service Center located in Lot 3.
- Pay the U-Pass fee of \$125 (cash and credit cards accepted).
- 4. Your campus ID will be affixed with a U-Pass sticker, or a U-Pass card will be issued. You must have your student ID to accompany your U-Pass card. The term is 19 to 23 weeks, effective term dates vary by semester.

Cal State LA semester parking permit holders are not eligible for U-Pass.
